Dear St Mary's Catholic Primary School,

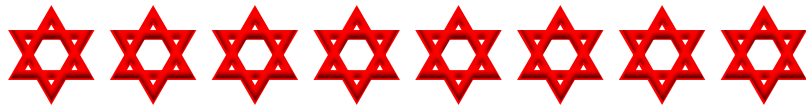
