

Reading

- Predicting outcomes ask questions as you read together
- Please sign the reading record book and write a comment after you have read with your child.





English and Maths

We have a new class story book each week based on either fiction, Non fiction or poetry

- * Holding the pencil correctly and good table posture
- * Form and orientate letters correctly
- * Sitting letters on the line and spacing our words
- Spellings we want the children's writing to flow – sounding out their words. We will fine tune spellings later in the year.
- Punctuation capital letters, full stops, question marks and speech marks later on in the year.

We follow White Rose in Maths.

- We use White Rose Maths supplemented by NCETM for mastery which is working in more depth looking at number.
- Schofield & Sims Mental Arithmetic books will be sent home after a baseline assessment.
- Encourage your child to make jottings and to develop a range of mental strategies

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All our topic work is cross curricular, for example English texts will link with our topics.
