Homework



- * Maths and English homework is given out on a Friday to be brought back in by the following Friday
 - * We mark in class together so that the children can understand how their answers could be better, ask questions and clear up any misunderstandings
 - * Maths is focused on the topic we are currently learning in class
 - * English is a reading focussed task
- * Spellings are given out on a Thursday and ‘tested’ the following Thursday
- * Please also encourage your child to read regularly at home and record it in their reading journal

English

- * We aim to inspire a love of reading by using engaging books to drive our curriculum in Guided Reading and in our Writing.
- * Our writing is inspired by the texts we read and the topics we are studying.



Maths

- * Maths is based on the White Rose scheme supplemented with *Mental Maths* sessions

Assessments

- * We undertake a range of assessments throughout the year, some formal and others informal, to track your child's attainment and progress and to help inform our teaching
- * This includes tests in Reading Comprehension, Maths, Spelling and Grammar each term and formal writing assessment
